4. Complete a *BLACKOUT* by filling in all the squares to get 5 additional entries in the grand prize drawing. Bring your completed card to the Reference Desk to receive your additional entries.
5. Rules of Play: Each book you read may only be used in one square. Limit one *BINGO* per person. Limit one *BLACKOUT* per person. **All entries must be submitted by 5pm on Friday, August 31.**
